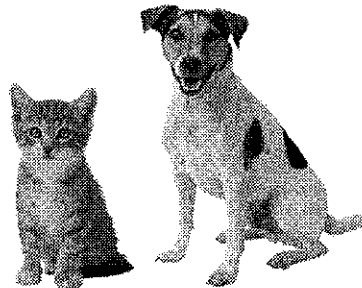

We look forward to seeing you in our new directory!

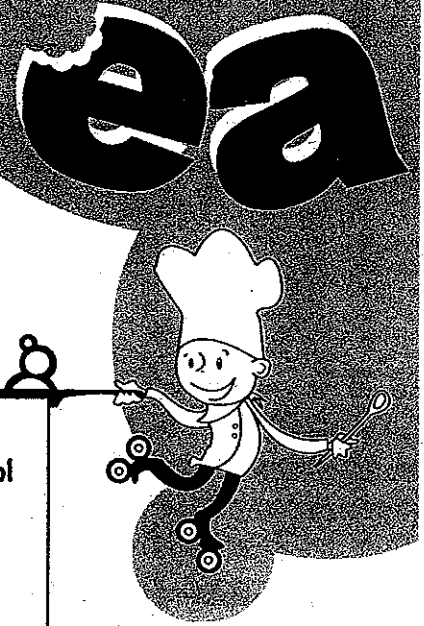
